Article 1. Approving the collaboration in providing the collaborative programme of BA (Hons) International Business Management between the following parties:

Article 2. Approving the collaboration in education with the following main contents:

1. Recruitment subjects:

- Vietnamese citizens who have graduated from high school or equivalent; and;
- Foreign citizens who have graduated from high school or equivalent.

2. Recruitment conditions:

Vietnamese citizens: Meet English grade of IELTS 6.0 (no skill below 5.5) or the entry requirements of the Collaboration Programme;

Foreign citizens: meet English grade of IELTS 6.0 (no skill below 5.5) or the entry requirements of the Collaboration Programme and the regulations on foreigners studying in Vietnam issued by the Ministry of Education and Training.

3. Duration and training programme:

3-year training period, divided into 6 semesters. The programme is fully delivered in Vietnam with the programme contents provided by Staffordshire University, totalling 360 UK credits.

4. Teaching Language: English.

5. Lecturer team:

All the lecturers from British University Vietnam and Staffordshire University, having professional qualifications and language met the requirements of the collaborative programme as well as the current regulations of both Vietnam and the UK.

6. Recruitment scale:

Year 1 (2023): 299

Year 2 (2024): 342

Year 3 (2025): 423

Year 4 (2026): 466

Year 5 (2027): 513

7. Teaching location: British University Vietnam.

8. Degree Certificate: Bachelor Degree of BA (Hons) International Business Management issued by the Staffordshire University.

9. Training cost and financial management: Training cost will be paid by learners in accordance with British University Vietnam's regulations. Tuition fee collection is published on the official website of British University Vietnam.

Article 3. Duration of the collaboration is 5 years from the date of this Decision.

Article 4. Relating schools and departments are responsible for annually reporting the collaboration implementation to the competent authorities in accordance with the current regulations.

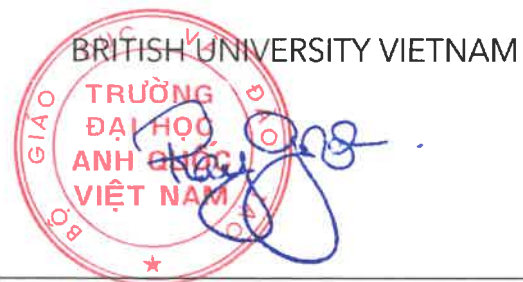
Article 5. Dean, Registrar, Discipline leads, relating departments and individuals are responsible for implementing this Decision.
